Application Instructions

Mixing Sequence: 1. Water 2. **Bean Builder** 3. Other ag chemicals.

Application Rate: Apply at the rate of 1 to 2 gallons per acre to correct deficiencies of listed nutrients.

Foliar Application: Apply Bean Builder with 20 gallons of water per acre through conventional sprayers. When using low volume equipment such as air sprayers, 5 to 10 gallons of water per acre are usually sufficient. This product can be used in combination with other chelate/citrate-based products and/or many pesticides. Apply in slow drying conditions. Do not apply if air temperature exceeds 90°F since damage to crop may occur.
