GENERAL INFORMATION

Cal-Bor™ is a liquid formulation designed to prevent and correct calcium and boron deficiencies in field crops, vegetables, tree crops, and vine crops. Calcium is an essential part of cell wall structure, therefore it is required to form new cells. Boron assists meristem cells in differentiating and also regulates plant metabolism. Cal-Bor™ may be used in conjunction with other nutritional programs for all crops requiring calcium and/or boron.

COMPATIBILITY

Cal-Bor™ is compatible with certain fertilizers and pesticides. A compatibility test is recommended if the desired combination has not been previously used.

MIXING DIRECTIONS

1. Add 1/3 of water to tank.
2. Add other chemicals, if any are used.
3. Add balance of water and agitate.
4. Add appropriate amount of Cal-Bor™

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

DO NOT APPLY this product to plants suffering from moisture stress or heat stress.

Multiple applications throughout the growing season will be necessary to help correct deficiencies once they occur. Best results occur when applications thoroughly cover actively growing plants.

For Field and Vegetable Crops: Apply desired rate throughout the growing season at regular intervals as necessary.

For Tree and Vine Crops: Start applications early in the growing season at pre-bloom, then continue throughout the season as required.

APPLICATION RATES

Foliar Application: Use 2 to 4 quarts Cal-Bor™ per acre per application using a minimum of 10 gallons of water as a carrier.

Soil Application: Use 4 to 8 quarts Cal-Bor™ per acre as a preplant or sidedress application.

Aerial Application: Use 1/2 to 1 quart Cal-Bor™ per acre with at least 5 gallons of water.
