MINT ENHANCER is a blend of macronutrients, micronutrients, soil penetrants, and NAP's Phosphate Enhancing STV chemistry for application in the first irrigation after cutting. It promotes water penetration and provides needed nutrients for fast regrowth.

The blend of macro and micronutrients in **MINT ENHANCER** is specifically designed to stimulate rapid regrowth of mint tops and roots after cutting, to promote plant health, and to help maintain levels of mint oil in the plant.

In addition, boron and molybdenum are often low to deficient in soils irrigated with river waters in the PNW. These micronutrients are necessary for good stands and production of mint.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Application Rate: Apply through the irrigation water at 2 to 5 gallons per acre in the first irrigation after cutting. Can also be beneficial when applied in the first and/or last irrigation of the season.

Do not mix with calcium or sulfate containing products.
